Youth Turkey Hunt scheduled for Kanopolis Lake

Marquette, KS – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) at Kanopolis Lake will host its youth turkey hunt Saturday April 2, 2016 on public lands managed by USACE. The select number of hunts will take place inside of refuge and park areas that are usually closed to hunting.

The hunt will allow hunters 15 years of age or younger to be drawn from a pool of applicants to hunt in an assigned area. Hunters are required to have a mentor (18 yrs. or older) with a valid Kansas Hunting License to assist the youth during the hunt, if you do not have a mentor one may be provided.

All applicable Kansas hunting regulations apply and required tags pertaining to the youth turkey season will be required. Please refer to the 2016 Kansas Hunting and Furharvesting Regulations Summary from Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism.
