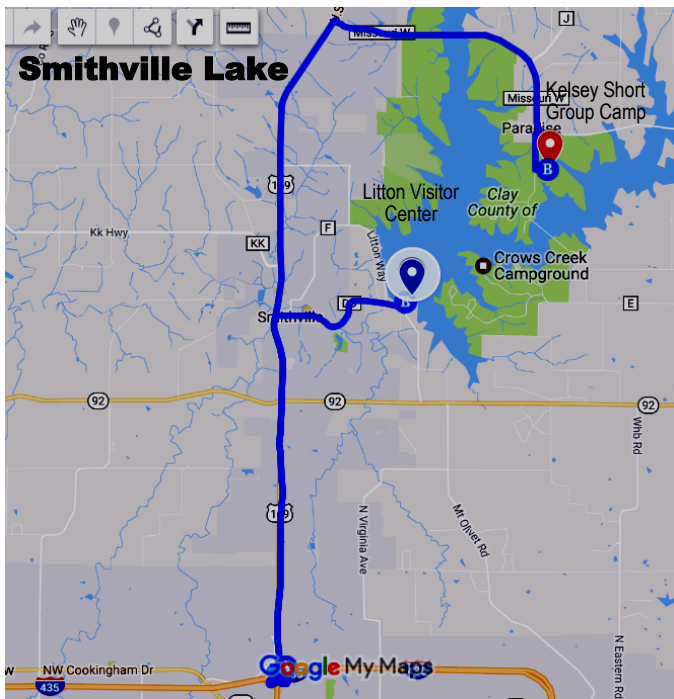

Directions to the Jerry Litton Visitor Center:

From 435 take the Mo Hwy 169 north to Smithville, turn right on DD highway through downtown Smithville. The Litton Visitor Center is located on the left side of the road, 0.25 miles past Litton Way.

Directions to Kelsey Short Group camp:

From 435 take MO Hwy 169 north past Smithville to Mo W Hwy, turn right onto W Hwy, then right and immediate left onto Paradise Rd, then Collins Road. Kelsey Short Camp is located on the left side of Collins Rd 0.25 miles south of the Paradise gas station.

Kids Intro to Honey Bees and Pollinators will be an indoor program with hands on interaction with some tools of the trade. (No bees will be inside the building.)

For Kid's Fishing: Children 15 and younger can fish without a permit. All others must have a fishing permit. Fishing poles and bait will be provided. ***Some crafts available*** Shelter area and grill nearby

For the Intro to Kayaking program, life vests will be provided and must be worn by all participants.

For the bicycle maintenance program, kids (and parents) have the option to bring their own bicycles to ride the gravel trail behind the visitor center after the program. We will not have any bicycles available to loan out.
