




Missouri River Recovery Program (MRRP)



MRRP Authorities and Mandate




Impacts to Navigation

- No intended impacts with habitat creation projects!
- Chutes designed to pass < 10% of flows to maintain navigation channel
- MRRP allows the Corps to operate the Missouri River system for all 8 congressionally authorized purposes.

- \$2.04 Billion total funding from FY06 to FY11






Missouri River Recovery Implementation Committee (MRRIC)



Missouri River Recovery Implementation Committee



- Formed July 1, 2008
- Provides a basin forum for collaboration on recovery activities
- Ensures consideration of public values and needs in recovery decisions
- Consists of broad range of basin tribes, states, stakeholders, and federal agencies
- Provides consensus-based recommendations to entities in the basin
- Serves as critical part of Adaptive Management


Jameson Island

- No current timeline for this project




Benedictine Bottoms

- Construction anticipated this Summer




Wilson Island

- Backwater Project




Little Sioux Bend
