




# Missouri Freight 2011

# Funding Sources

- Federal – none
- Missouri General Revenue
- State Transportation Fund (226.225 RSMo)
- STAR Loan Fund – MHTC application

# Missouri General Revenue

- Legislative Appropriation Needed
- Compete with all state government needs
- \$3 million capital improvements requested for FY14 with MoDOT's budget
- No capital improvement funding since 2009

# State Transportation Fund

- Legislative Appropriation Needed
- Limited to non-highway transportation needs
- MoDOT Budget request includes:
  - \$850,000 for Freight Enhancement Program (new)
  - \$375,000 Port Administration

# STAR Loans

- Application to MTFC through MoDOT
- Limited to non-highway transportation
- Public Entity or Non-profit private entity
- Low Interest Loans
- Capital Improvement or Operating

# MHTC Discusses Future

- MoDOT developed multimodal funding proposal
- [www.MoDOT.org](http://www.MoDOT.org)
- Project-specific list for voters; generated from On the Move plan & regional priorities
- 1 cent sales tax generating \$7.9 billion
- 5% to city, 5% to county
- I-70 rebuilt in 5 years

# Legislative Proposals

- SJR 16 and HJR 23
- 1% sales and use tax
- 10 year sunset
- Vote by people
