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

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Munitions Sites

- Creek Area of Interest



Creek is located in southwest corner of FUDS, within former Demolition Grounds MRA

Inspection area is the creek bed, with a 20-ft wide area on either side, from the southwestern grid to Highway 66.

3 R's of Explosives Safety

■ Recognize

- ▶ Unexpected shapes and sizes
- ▶ Still dangerous if old or damaged
- ▶ Often-handled “souvenirs” can explode



■ Retreat

- ▶ Don't touch or move it
- ▶ Carefully leave the area
