



Penninsula campground sites that are non-reservable are B-35,36,41,42,56 and C-69,78



Rock Creek Park

Welcome to Rock Creek Park! Located adjacent to the Rock Creek segment of Perry Lake and hosts a variety of fun-filled activities for people of all ages.

The 568 acre park is located on the west side of the lake north of the dam. Facilities include: 112 designated campsites (65 with electrical and water), boat ramp, dump station, reservable group picnic shelter house, shower/latrine, courtesy dock, and playground.

Primitive camping is allowed at Big Rocks, Brown County Cove, Walnut Grove, and Windmill. Visitors may choose a site and purchase a permit at the Corps gate booth. State park camping permits are not valid in Corps of Engineers parks.

Fees

Campsite fees are \$18 for 50-amp electric/water sites, \$17 for 30-amp electric/water sites, and \$12 for non-electric sites from 16 April - 15 October. Portions of the park are open to self pay camping after 15 October; however no waterborne facilities are available.

**Each campsite is allowed either two tents or one RV type vehicle and one tent, if applicable*

Reservations

- Three options are available for reserving facilities:
 - Reserve campsites at the campground.
 - Call the National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS) At: 1-877-444-6777.

- Reservations are recommended on holiday weekends. Not all sites are reservable.

Rules and Regulations

- Please use complimentary trash bags and deposit trash in dumpsters upon departure.
- Please keep pets on a leash.
- No kegs or party balls allowed.
- Quiet hours: 10 pm-6 am.
- All visitors must leave by 10:00 PM. *Visitor fees of \$5.00 per car are in effect on holiday weekends.*
- Check-in and checkout is 6:00 PM.
- Registered vehicles only, ATVS, dirtbikes, golf carts, etc. not allowed.

Perry Lake Camping

Five campgrounds are conveniently located around Perry Lake. The Corps manages four of these campgrounds, Rock Creek, Slough Creek, Longview, and Old Town. The Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks manages Perry State Park.

Holders of Golden Age Passports, Golden Access Passports and the "America the Beautiful Interagency Pass" receive a 50 percent discount on the camping and day use fees in the Corps-managed areas.

Entrance stations are located at all fee campgrounds and are routinely patrolled by Park Rangers and Jefferson County Sheriff's Deputies.


