


Sites 2, 4, 7, 30, 34 and 36 have electric and water hook-ups



Locust


No dogs allowed

Sites 3,4,5,7,10,13, and 17-24 have electric and water hook-ups.




Worthington




South Point

Slough Creek Park

Welcome to Slough Creek Park!
Located adjacent to the Big Slough Creek arm of Perry Lake, Slough Creek is the largest Corps park on the lake and hosts a variety of fun-filled activities for people of all ages.

The 833 acre park is located on the east side of the lake and facilities include: 270 campsites (41 with electricity and 78 with electricity and water), a boat ramp, 2 dump stations, 2 reservable group camp areas, 2 shower houses, courtesy docks, picnic area, and playgrounds. The park also includes the 2½ mile Thunder Ridge educational trail as well as access to the 29 mile Perry Lake Trail.

Fees

Campsite fees are \$18 for 50-amp electric/water sites, \$17 for 30-amp electric/water sites, \$16 for electric sites and \$12 for non-electric sites from 16 April - 15 October. The Park is closed after 15 October with the exception of the group camp areas that are available for year round use.

*Each campsite is allowed either two tents or one RV type vehicle and one tent, if applicable.

Reservations

- Three options are available for reserving facilities:
 - Reserve campsites at the campground gatebooth.
 - Call the National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS) at: 1-877-444-6777.

- Reservations are recommended on holiday weekends. Not all sites are reservable.

Rules and Regulations

- Please use complimentary trash bags and deposit trash in dumpsters upon departure.
 - Please keep pets on a leash.
 - No dogs are allowed in the Locust camping area
 - Quiet hours: 10 pm - 6 am.
 - All visitors must leave by 10:00 PM. *Visitor fees of \$5.00 per car are in effect on Holiday weekends.*
 - Check-in and checkout is 6:00 PM.
 - A complete list of Title 36 Rules and Regulations are available at the Gate Booth.
 - No Kegs or Party Balls allowed.
 - Registered vehicles only, ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts, etc. not allowed
 - Gates closed from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am on Friday and Saturday
- *Boat and swim safely! Wear a life* jacket and stay sober!**

Perry Lake Camping

Five campgrounds are conveniently located around Perry Lake. The Corps manages four of these campgrounds, Rock Creek, Slough Creek, Longview, and Old Town. The Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks manages Perry State Park.

Holders of Golden Age and Golden Access Passports or "America The Beautiful Interagency Pass" receive a 50 percent discount on the camping fees in the Corps-managed areas.

Entrance stations are located at all fee campgrounds and are patrolled routinely by Park Rangers and Jefferson County Sheriff's Deputies.
