


Slough Creek Park

Welcome to Slough Creek Park! Located adjacent to the Big Slough Creek arm of Perry Lake, the park is the second largest on the lake and hosts a variety of fun-filled activities for people of all ages.

The 833 acre park is located on the east side of the lake and facilities include: 270 campsites (41 with electricity and 78 with electricity and water), a boat ramp, 2 dump stations, 2 reservable group camp areas, 3 shower houses, courtesy docks and picnic area. The park also includes the 2½ mile Thunder Ridge educational trail as well as access to the 29 mile Perry Lake Trail.

Fees

Campsite fees are \$18.00 for 50amp electric/water sites, \$17.00 for 30amp electric/water sites, \$16.00 for electric sites, and \$10.00 for non-electric sites from 16 April – 15 October.



Reservations

Three options are available for reserving facilities:

- Reservations are recommended on holiday weekends. Not all sites are reservable.

Rules and Regulations

- Please use complimentary trash bags and deposit trash in dumpsters upon departure.
- Please keep pets on a leash.
- No dogs allowed are allowed in the Locust camping area
- Quiet hours: 10 pm-6 am.
- All visitors must leave by 10:00 PM. Visitor fees of \$5.00 per car are in effect on Holiday weekends.
- Check-in and checkout is 6:00 PM.

Perry Lake Camping

Five campgrounds are conveniently located around Perry Lake. The Corps manages four of these campgrounds, Rock Creek, Slough Creek, Longview, and Old Town. The Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks manages Perry State Park.

Holder of the America the Beautiful Senior or Access or Golden Age and Golden Access Passports receive a 50 percent discount on the camping fees in the Corps-managed areas.

Entrance stations are located at all fee campgrounds and are patrolled routinely by Park Rangers and Jefferson County Sheriff's Deputies.




Bur Oak

Locust


Sites 4,5,6,8,11,14 and 18-25 have electric and water hook-ups.

All sites have electricity except 38-51.




Water spigots are indicated with a water drop icon.

South Point



Site numbers 6,10,13,17,19,21,27, 31,33,and 64-78 have electric and water.
