

WELCOME TO ROCKHAVEN PARK

Please observe the following rules while in the park. Keep in mind that these rules not only protect park resources and visitor safety, but also reflect common courtesy toward other park visitors.

1. Campsites are available on a first-come, first-serve basis only. Reserving of campsites is prohibited. Campers should select site, make camp and immediately register and pay for the campsite at the entrance kiosk. Campers may register only for his/her own site. Holding, reserving, or registering other campsites is not allowed. Overnight occupancy is required at all campsites.
2. Camping fees are collected per campsite. To avoid overcrowding sites, a maximum of 2 units is allowed per site. (2 tents or 1 tent and 1 wheeled camping unit) Campsites 1-5 and 22-50 are for equestrian campers only.
3. Horses must not be tethered directly to or in trees, however, hitching rings and tie lines may be used.
4. Day use parking is provided at the entrance to Rockhaven Park. Picnicking is not permitted in campgrounds.
5. Travel and parking are only allowed on park roadways. When parking at campsites, keep at least 2 wheels on the road or camp pad.
6. Quiet hours, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., are strictly enforced. Non-campers must be out of the park by 10 p.m. For late night problems, call the Douglas County Sheriff at 785-843-0250.
7. All pets must be kept on a leash not more than 6 feet in length. Pets are not allowed in the shower building or restroom.
8. Please keep a clean campsite during your stay. Place all garbage in the dumpster. Two concrete compost pens have been provided for disposal of horse manure from campsites and horse corrals. (Please clean site of manure before leaving)
9. Gray water or any other liquid waste material discharge is prohibited.
10. Fires are allowed in designated fire rings only. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for firewood. Please do not dispose of trash in fire rings or grills.
11. All motorized vehicles (including mopeds, mini-bikes and ATV's) ridden on park roads must be licensed for the road and the operator is required to have a valid license.
12. Please report any theft, loss, accident or disturbance to Park Rangers or the Park Volunteer.
