

Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. No generators, radios, or other noise producing devices shall be operated during these hours.

All pets must be on a leash or otherwise restrained in a kennel or vehicle at ALL times. Pet owners are responsible for removal and proper disposal of all pet waste.

Cutting of any trees or parts thereof is prohibited. Wood lying on the ground may be picked up for campfires.

All sewage and “gray water” must be contained and disposed of at the dump station.

An extra site fee is charged if more than one camping unit is set up on a site. A camping unit is defined as “one wheeled unit and one tent OR two tents”.

# Damsite Park

## Pomme de Terre Lake



Located on the Pomme de Terre River Arm of Pomme de Terre Lake. From Springfield MO: Take US 65 north 60 miles to Preston MO. Take Hwy 54 west to Hermitage, MO. Take Hwy 254/64 south to Carsons Corner, take Hwy 254 west toward the Dam. The entrance to Damsite Park is on the south side of 254.

It is not necessary to make a reservation however reservations can be made. Reservations must be made at least 3 days in advance. There is a 2 night minimum stay on weekends and a 3 night minimum stay on holiday weekends. Campsite fees are \$12 - \$20 per night. Reservations may be made by calling toll free 877-444-6777, or online at [www.Recreation.gov](http://www.Recreation.gov).

Damsite Park is open year round, however the amenities are only available April 16 to September 30.
