Fish Attractor Policy

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers does allow private individuals to place fish attractors into the waters of Pomme de Terre Lake as long as they adhere to the following criteria.

- Only natural materials may be used, such as brush, wood, tree limbs, etc.
- Fish attractors should be placed in areas where they will not create any safety hazard to swimmers or boaters.
- They should not be placed along the shoreline of any campground, swim beach or boat ramp nor within 500 feet of the control/intake structure.
- All fish attractors placed shall be anchored or weighted sufficiently to keep them in place so as not to create a floating hazard to boaters.
- The cutting of trees, brush or other material from public land around the lake is prohibited.
- The placement of fish attractors into public waters makes them open and free to use by the public, the person who places them has no special rights to their use.
