

Please follow these trail rules:

Stay on designated trail.

- No glass containers on trail. Please do not litter.
- Trails closed during firearms deer season.
- Trails closed until 1 PM during spring turkey season.
- No unauthorized flagging may be used to mark trails without written permission.
- Horses should be shod.
- Horses must cross blacktop roads at designated crossings.
- Any hazards or unsafe conditions should be reported to the Pomme de Terre Project Office (417) 745-6411.
- All vehicles must park on paved roads.
- No camping.
- The trail is designated for equestrian, hiking, and biking use only. No motorized vehicles.

In case of an emergency contact the Polk County Sheriff Department or Emergency Services by dialing 911.



Directions to Pomme de Terre Multipurpose Trail

From Bolivar

- North on D Hwy for 7 miles to PP Hwy.
- North on PP Hwy for 2 miles.
- Continue North on RB Hwy for 4 miles. Take final left turn before Bolivar Landing Boat Ramp.

From Louisburg

- West on 64 Hwy for 10 miles to Mohawk Corner
- Continue west for 4 miles to RB Hwy.
- North on RB Hwy for 2 miles.
- Take final left turn before Bolivar Landing Boat Ramp.




