The Pomme de Terre River is nestled among the bluffs and hills of Hickory County. This natural landscape is perfect for a peaceful day on the river.

The river offers excellent recreational opportunities. One may take advantage of the fine fishing or simply float along and enjoy the beautiful Ozark scenery.


There are five access points available for public use; Outlet Park, Hermitage, Cross Timbers, Slick Rock and Sapps Landing.

Canoeing and kayaking are very popular during the summer months. Optimal floating conditions are when the lake is releasing between 100 to 800 cfs (cubic feet per second) into the river. During high release rates the river may become subject to sudden rise and turbulence.
