Corps announces lake use fees for 2014

MANHATTAN, Kan.—The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Tuttle Creek Lake offers many opportunities for outdoor recreation, and reservations may be made for shelters for \$25 per day.

Reservations for picnic shelters in the Outlet Park and Tuttle Creek Cove may be reserved for gatherings at the Corps of Engineers office at 5020 Tuttle Creek Boulevard.

Campsites in Tuttle Creek Cove and Stockdale cost \$18 per night with electrical and water hookups. Without these amenities the cost is \$12 per night. Campsites in these parks may be reserved in advance by calling (877) 444-6777 or logging on to www.recreation.gov.

After May 15 it will cost \$1 per person over 12 years of age to use the swimming beach in Tuttle Creek Cove. There is a maximum charge of \$4 per vehicle. The fee to launch a boat at the Tuttle Creek Cove boat ramp is \$3. Self-pay stations are conveniently located near both of these fee areas and at the park entrance booth. If you are going to use these facilities regularly, an annual permit is available at the Corps office for \$30.

Anyone 12 years old or younger must wear a lifejacket on the lake. The only areas on Tuttle Creek Lake where you may not boat is around the swim beach, the control tower and below the “tubes.” The staff at the lake welcomes the public to come out and enjoy the lake safely
