

Wildflower Walk

Please join a park ranger on a Tuttle Creek Wildflower Walk, scheduled for Saturday, September 13. Plan to arrive at the Tuttle Creek Lake Visitor Center, 5020 Tuttle Creek Blvd., by 10:00 am. After introductions we will carpool to the site, about two miles distant. The site selected has an established roadway, so we will not be walking through tall grass. Wearing a broad-brimmed hat and closed-toed shoes is a good idea, and if it is warm, bring water to drink. We will return to the visitor center by noon.

Konza Prairie docents and botanists will help us identify and learn about the native flowering plants on a nice parcel of tall grass prairie, with some amazing flowers this time of year. Call the Corps of Engineers at (785) 539-8511 to preregister, so that we know how many persons to expect.
