

# WELCOME TO WILSON LAKE

**Please observe the following rules while in the park. Keep in mind that these rules not only protect park resources and visitor safety, but also reflect common courtesy toward other park visitors.**

1. Campsites are available on a first-come, first-serve basis, unless a reservation has been made through the NRRS. Check Out is at 6:00 p.m.
2. Campers should check at fee booth for site availability, some campsites might be reserved. If booth is closed, refer to Registration Information sign, select site, make camp and return to fee booth when open. Campers may register only for his/her own site. "Holding", reserving, or registering other campsites is not allowed.
3. Camping fees are collected per camp site. To avoid overcrowding sites, a maximum of 2 units is allowed per site (2 tents or 1 tent and 1 trailer)
4. Day use is permitted in all parks. However all day users not fishing must leave the park at 10:00 p.m.
5. When parking at campsites, attempt to keep at least 2 wheels on the road or camp pad.
6. 3 vehicles are allowed per site, extra vehicles can be parked in parking lot areas.
- 7. Quiet hours, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., are strictly enforced. Visitors must depart camping areas by 10 p.m.**
- 8. All pets must be kept on a leash not more than 6 feet in length. Domesticated "wild" animals are not allowed in the park area. Pets are not allowed in shower buildings, restrooms or on the swimming beach.**
9. Please keep a clean campsite. All trash should be deposited in the dumpsters upon departure.
10. Gray water or any liquid waste material discharge is permitted at dump stations only.
11. Fires are allowed in designated fire rings only. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for firewood. Please do not dispose of trash in fire rings or grills.
12. All vehicles (including mopeds, mini-bikes and ATV's) ridden on park roads must be licensed for the road and the operator is required to have a valid license.
13. Please report any theft, loss, accident or disturbance to Park Rangers or Park Attendants.
