

Wilson Lake – Corps of Engineers Camping Policy and Regulations

Site Limits

Maximum Camping Units per site:

Campsites are limited to 8 people including 1 *wheeled camper and 1 tent, or just 2 tents. Tents are limited to adjacent turf capacity off gravel pad as to not encroach on adjacent campsite turf and pad, or cause potential problems as determined by a Park Ranger or Park Attendant.

*1 additional tent may be purchased and permitted for each site = \$12/night

* A “wheeled unit” is defined for our purposes as an RV, motor-home, pop-up camper, pickup camper, or van.

Paid customers that are camping are exempt from boat ramp fees but require Courtesy Hang Tags for Boat Ramps, available to all paying campers at the booth.

Group Camp Sylvan=8 sites, \$100/night, Lucas=15 sites, \$150/night, Minooka=12sites, \$150/night

Day Use Fee at Boat Ramps \$3/day (Minooka West/Middle/East, Spillway Ramp)

Weekends have a 2 night stay minimum and Holidays have a 3 night minimum.

Rules and Regulations

1. Picnic tables and fire-rings must remain at designated sites.
2. Quiet hours from 10pm to 6am. Day use ends at 10pm.
3. Improper dumping of **gray water** (i.e. wastewater from sinks, dish washing etc...) is prohibited. Please dispose of your gray water properly at provided sanitary disposal stations.
4. Campsites should be kept clean at all times.
5. **Camping permits should be purchased by 6 p.m. Permits should be displayed on the site post or camping unit and readable from the outside.**
6. Fireworks not permitted on any Federal property.
7. All vehicles must attempt to have at least one wheel on gravel. 3 vehicles maximum/campsite.
8. All general public vehicles used in the parks shall be operated in accordance with Federal and State law. ATV's, golf carts, unregistered motorcycles, unregistered motor/electric scooters, go-peds, etc. are prohibited on park roadways and landscape.
9. All dogs (and other pets) must be kept on a leash, not attached to a tree, under six feet in length.
10. Campsites must be occupied daily. Camping equipment must be removed at the end of paid site occupancy.

Failure to comply with these regulations may result in a citation according to Federal Rules and Regulations – Title 36. Additional rules and regulations are present in Title 36.
