Joshua. The lat/long associated with the subject permit is located approximately 3,800' from the end of Runway 17-35. Jet fuel is not sold at the Gardner Municipal Airport, so the 5,000' limit would apply. There is an instrument approach, but it is not specific to any particular runway, so you do not have to worry about areas beyond the 5,000'

New Century Airfield is about 4 miles east-northeast of your site and does sell jet fuel, so the 10,000' limit would apply to that airport. The only instrument approach associated with a runway is on Runway 18-36. You should stay out of that approach/departure out to 5 miles. Call if you have questions.

1. To find out information about an airport, including jet fuel sales, go to: <http://www.gcrl.com/5010web/> After you find the airport you want, click on the "Services & Facilities" tab. If the letter "A" appears next to fuel, then the airports sells "Jet A" or "jetfuel." In that case, the larger 10,000' limit applies.
2. The Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5200-33 has had three versions dated 5/1/97, 7/27/04, and 8/28/07. The latter two versions carry the revision letters "A" and "B" respectively. AC 150/5200-34 (landfill only) has had two versions dated 8/8/00 and 1/26/06 with the last version carrying the revision letter "A".
