I demand a **full** environmental study on the impact this intermodal will have on this area through the water shed, endanger species, wetlands, air pollution and diesel particles.

This proposed intermodal is located in the prevailing winds southwest of Gardner in **CLOSE** proximity of residences.

Kansas City has failed in its standards in smog and air pollution and the impact of this industry could have a very strong impact not only on Gardner but Kansas City and it's greater areas.
