Notice of Proposed Adverse Effects to a Warren Pony Truss Bridge in Jackson County, Kansas

The Kansas City District will comply with the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and 36 CFR 800. The purpose of this public notice is to allow the public to express their views on resolving adverse effects concerning the proposed replacement of an 80 foot warren pony truss bridge that was constructed in circa 1925 and replace it with an 80 foot pre-built metal span bridge. Through consultation with the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), the Corps has determined the structure is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion A. The bridge replacement is eligible for Nationwide Permit (NWP) 14; however, in accordance with NWP general condition 18, the project must comply with the provisions of 33 CFR Part 325, Appendix C. Through consultation with the SHPO, a mitigation plan was developed that would require Jackson County to solicit proposals seeking adaptive reuse of the bridge at a new location, from anyone willing to move, re-erect, maintain, and assume financial and legal responsibility for the bridge. Recordation of the structure will also be completed by the submittal of digital photographs to the SHPO. ACTIVITY: The applicant proposes to replace an 80 foot warren pony truss bridge with an 80 foot pre-built metal span bridge. The activity is eligible by NWP No. 14 pending consultation under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) of 1966 (amended 1992).

PUBLIC HEARING: Any person may request, in writing, prior to the expiration date of this public notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application. Such requests shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing.
