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**Notice of Proposed Adverse Effects  
to a 2 @ 10' x 6' Native Stone Bridge (Bridge #650)  
in Barton County, Kansas**

The Kansas City District will comply with the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and 36 CFR 800. The purpose of this public notice is to allow the public to express their views on resolving adverse effects concerning the proposed replacement of a 2 @ 10' x 6' native stone bridge (Bridge #650) that was constructed in 1938 and which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The bridge replacement is eligible for Nationwide Permit (NWP) 14; however, in accordance with NWP general condition 18, the project must comply with the provisions of 33 CFR Part 325, Appendix C. **PROJECT LOCATION** (As shown on the attached drawings): The project is located on a tributary to Beaver Creek in Section 8, Township 16 South, Range 12 West, Barton County, Kansas.

Latitude: 38.6810 – Longitude: -98.6642

**AUTHORITY:** Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 USC 1344).

**ACTIVITY:** Barton County is proposing to replace a 2 @ 10' x 6' native stone bridge (Bridge #650) with a 3 @ 8' x 6' concrete box culvert. The construction will provide a wider roadway and flatter shoulder slopes to better accommodate wide loads such as farm equipment. The activity is authorized by NWP No. 14 pending consultation under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) of 1966 (amended 1992).

**PUBLIC HEARING:** Any person may request, in writing, prior to the expiration date of this public notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application. Such requests shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing.
