


# Hillsdale Lake

1	Jayhawker Marina	Catfish, Crappie, Bluegill, Heated dock
2	Sunflower Day Use Area	Catfish, Crappie, Carp - Easy access to water
3	Scotts Creek Bridge	Catfish and Crappie - Muddy Slopes
4	Wades Branch Access	Catfish, Crappie, Carp – Canoe and Small Boat Launch
5	Rock Creek Bridge	Catfish and Crappie – Canoe and Small Boat Launch
6	Big Bull Creek Bridge	Catfish and Crappie – Use Parking Lot
7	Antioch Boat Ramp	Catfish and Crappie – Easy Access and Rip Rap
8	Smith Creek Access	Catfish and Crappie
9	Hillsdale Point Boat Ramp	Catfish and Crappie – Rip Rap Breakwaters
10	Cedar Niles Access	Catfish and Crappie – Canoe and Small Boat Launch
11	Bev Lou Area	Catfish, Crappie, Bluegill – Weedy Walk to Shoreline
12	Tontzville Bridge	Catfish, Crappie, Bass – Rip Rap & Brush, Use Parking Lots
13	Marysville Boat Ramp	Catfish, Crappie, Bass – Mowed Shoreline
14	Hillsdale Dam	Walleye, Crappie, Bass – Rip Rap with lots of walking
15	Outlet Area	Catfish, Crappie, Walleye – Concrete Walkways

### Rules to Observe

- State and Federal Hunting Regulations are enforced.
- All vehicles must stay on maintained roads and parking lots.
- Do not park on bridges.
- Camping and fires are permitted only in the State Park Campgrounds.
- Deer Stands must be portable.
- Duck blinds must be made of natural materials. Permanent blinds are prohibited.
- Steel Shot is required for all Migratory Bird hunting.
- State Park Vehicle Permits are required in designated areas.
- Permits and licenses are available at the State Park Office.



### Lake Levels

The lake level can vary, depending on seasons and weather conditions. Contact the Project Office for current information on lake levels.

- Multipurpose Pool 917 m.s.l.
- Flood Pool 931 m.s.l.
