3 ways to register:


NOTE: When registering for the first time it will ask for a username and password. You can input any combination of characters. Remember that your username and password is case sensitive. **You must remember your username and password.** The password is encrypted; therefore I cannot tell you what your password is if you forget it.

If you are registering for the first time go to

1. Click on the solicitation number and click on **register for this solicitation**

2. Click on the page that lists all the solicitations, click on **ALREADY REGISTERED?**
This option will show you which solicitations you have registered for. It will allow you to register for solicitations that you have not previously registered for.
