## Day Use Fees


A daily use fee may be charged in day use parks for certain recreational activities. Signs are posted in these areas advising when the fee will be collected and how much the fee will be. Campers who are registered in Corps of Engineers' campgrounds are not charged a day use fee as long as they are displaying a current camper registration tag in their vehicle. An annual day use fee permit can be purchased at the Milford Lake Project Office.

## We Need Your Help

Milford Lake has approximately 1.3 million visitors per year. Help us to protect the natural resources by:

1. Keeping all vehicles off the grass.
2. All pets are to be physically restrained while in the park area. Swimming beaches are "off limits" to pets for sanitary and health reasons.
3. Fishing within the limits of the marked swimming area is not allowed for safety reasons. Lost fishing hooks can be an unwelcome surprise to bare feet.
4. Please do not litter. Day Use Parks are seasonally open from 7 AM to 10 PM.


