Corps set to teach Topeka, Lawrence officials flood fighting Thursday

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Kansas City District will teach more than 20 Topeka and Lawrence levee officials the basics of flood fighting from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thursday at the Topeka Wastewater Treatment Facility at 115 NE Poplar.

The course will provide basic flood fight training during a morning classroom session and an afternoon hands-on circuit of scenario-based practical exercises.

“The practical portion of the training will allow the participants to actually experience situations likely to occur during a flood,” said Jud Kneuvean, the Corps’ natural disaster program manager in Kansas City.

The hands-on portion of the instruction is slated for 1 to 3 p.m. on the levee behind the wastewater facility.
