## **Special hunt scheduled for Bloomington Park at Clinton Lake**

LAWRENCE, Kans. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Clinton Lake will host its second annual special hunt at Bloomington Park November 1-30.

The hunt, an archery-only event, allows hunters to be drawn from a pool of applicants to hunt on assigned land. Hunters are required to carry a “special hunt” permit issued by the Corps and follow all Kansas statutes. Normally, hunting is not permitted in park areas at Clinton Lake.

Last year’s hunt was a great success for the participants. “I would love to see this special hunt continued, particularly if Kansas continues to have trouble with the increasing deer populations,” said George Frederickson who participated in the hunt. “I would also like to see this hunt become a ‘buddy hunt.’” In response to these suggestions from last year’s hunters, the Corps of Engineers at Clinton Lake will permit a hunter and their selected co-participant to participate in the hunt event.

Another change from last year is the addition of two hunt zones located within Rockhaven Park.
