## Milford Lake to hold family fishing pond dedication Saturday

JUNCTION CITY, Kans. - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will host a ceremony at 10 a.m. June 5 at Milford Lake to dedicate a family fishing pond in Outlet Park.

The pond is the result of a partnership between local, state, and federal agencies to provide a venue for families and physically challenged outdoor enthusiasts.
