Salina RAB to meet May 4

SALINA, Kan. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Kansas City District, will host a restoration advisory board (RAB) meeting regarding the former Schilling Air Force Base at 7 p.m. this Thursday, May 4, in the Kansas State University-Salina Conference Room, Salina, Kan.

In addition to reporting about ongoing testing at the site, Kansas City District officials plan to discuss concerns raised by an independent study of groundwater contamination at the site performed by a consultant hired by public entities in the Salina area and presented in a public meeting Feb. 23.

The RAB is part of the ongoing community involvement efforts by the Corps in conjunction with the remediation of the former defense site.

The Corps is responsible for mediation of groundwater contamination at the site that may have been caused by its former use as a World War II bomber training base and a Strategic Air Command Missile Base.
