## **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to offer 17th annual deer hunt for physically challenged at Smithville Lake**

**Smithville, Mo.** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Smithville Lake will play host to the 17th annual managed deer hunt for physically challenged deer hunters Nov. 18 and 19, 2006.

Hunters who have permanent mobility impairments confining them to a wheelchair or requiring the use of canes, crutches or walkers qualify for the hunt. Preference will be given to those confined to wheelchairs.

Provided guides will take hunters to and from pre-constructed blinds. Local Boy Scouts and Kiwanis Club members will provide lunch.

Hunters that are accepted must purchase a managed deer hunt license costing \$17.00. Three deer may be harvested, one may be an antlered buck.
