Smithville Lake Youth & Disabled Hunter managed Turkey Hunt, May 5th & 6th

SMITHVILLE, Mo. – The US Army Corp of Engineers, in cooperation with Missouri Department of Conservation, and Clay County Parks are seeking applicants to participate in the Third Annual Smithville Lake Youth & Disabled Hunter Managed Turkey Hunt, May 5 and 6.

This year's hunt will allow 10 youths from age 11 through 15 and 10 hunters confined to wheelchairs, to hunt in areas near Smithville Lake which are not normally open to public hunting.

Successful applicants will be asked to attend a pre-hunt orientation from 1:30 to 5 p.m., Saturday, April 7, 2007 at the Smithville Lake Jerry Litton Visitor Center.
