## Special hunt scheduled at Clinton Lake

**Lawrence, Kans.** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Clinton Lake, along with Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks and the National Wild Turkey Federation, will play host to its second Youth Turkey Hunt at Clinton Lake, April 7, 2007.

The Clinton Lake Youth Turkey Hunt allows hunters to be drawn from a pool of applicants to hunt in an assigned area. Hunters must carry a "special hunt permit" issued by the Corps. All hunting must be in compliance with Kansas statutes. Normally, hunting is not permitted in these areas at Clinton Lake.

The purpose of the special hunt is to encourage young hunters to become interested in turkey hunting and to do so in an ethical manner. Young hunters, between the ages of 10 and 16, with the assistance of a mentor will be selected to hunt in designated areas. If the young hunter does not have access to an adult guide, one will be provided.
