2007 WATERFOWL BLIND REGISTRATION FOR TRUMAN LAKE

U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, HARRY S. TRUMAN LAKE, WARSAW, MISSOURI.

The waterfowl blind registration process for the 2007 Missouri Waterfowl Season has been finalized for Harry S. Truman Lake. Hunters wishing to place a waterfowl hunting blind on Truman Lake may register at the Harry S. Truman Visitor Center on Friday, September 14th from 8:30 - 9:00 a.m. A lottery drawing for blind sites will follow the registration.

The procedure for registering waterfowl blinds will be as follows:

- Participants must be at least 16 years of age, possess a 2007 Federal Migratory Bird Stamp and provide valid proof of identification.
- Registration numbers will be randomly drawn to determine the order of blind site selections. Each participant will be allowed to select a blind location in the order they were drawn. Additional drawings will be conducted allowing participants who wish additional blinds to select locations in other zones on the lake. Each participant is allowed only one blind per hunting zone. There are 4 hunting blind zones on the lake.
- Additional walk-in blind registrations will be accepted after the official drawing, but only through October 1. Blind sites will be registered in the order submitted. All blinds must maintain a 300-yard distance from previously registered blind sites.
