Corps awards contract to clean Kansas missile silos

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – A Milwaukee engineering and science firm has been awarded a \$229,000 contract to clean suspected source areas of contamination at two former missile silos in central Kansas.

The Kansas City District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers awarded TN and Associates the \$229,232 contract to clean the sumps, sediment traps and flame tunnels at the former Forbes Atlas Missile Site (S-7) near Wamego, Kans., and the former Forbes Atlas Missile Site (S-6) near Keene, Kans.

Work is scheduled to begin at the sites in March.

The two missile sites were constructed in the early 1960s to defend the now closed Forbes Airfield in Topeka, Kans.
