



**Invitation to Comment on the Proposed No Action Plan for
Selected Areas of Concern and Areas of Interest at the
Former Tyson Valley Powder Farm**

You have the opportunity to provide comments on the Proposed No Action Plan for Selected Areas of Concern (AOC) and Areas of Interest (AOI) at the Former Tyson Valley Powder Farm. The United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) would like to hear your views about the plan. USACE has investigated these 10 AOCs and 6 AOIs and believes that the proposed No Action Plan is appropriate.

The selected AOCs and AOIs include the following sites:

AOC 9C	Firing Points and Bullet Drops AOC 9C	AOI	Former Mercury Bin/Truck Inspection Site
AOC 10	Scrap Metal Open Dump Site	AOI	Railroad Pond

These AOCs and AOIs have been investigated by both USACE and the USEPA. The environmental investigations have followed the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act process. As part of this process USACE has performed a human health and environmental risk screening and evaluation for the selected 10 AOCs and 6 AOIs:

- Analytical results of detected chemicals were compared to risk-based screening levels and evaluated
- Risk evaluations followed appropriate State and Federal guidance
- Results indicated no significant threat to human health or the environment
